


Treatment for Cocaine Use Disorder

Percentage of Unduplicated Clients in SFY 2017

Map Information:

This map represents the percentage of unduplicated clients with a primary diagnosis of cocaine use disorder (CUD) served in each county during SFY 2017. The average rate of clients with a primary diagnosis of CUD across counties was 4.6%. The highest rates were found in Cuyahoga county (9.1%), Erie county (8.6%), and Hancock county (7.6%). The lowest rates were found in Clermont county (1.4%), Athens county (1.9%), and Warren county (2.1%). Counties that reported fewer than 25 clients are signified by gray, and no rate is given. Counties with 25-49 clients are signified by diagonal lines. County borders are outlined in gray. ADAMHS Boards areas are outlined in black, and may overlap county borders.
