


# Treatment for Opiate Use Disorder

## Percentage of Unduplicated Clients in SFY 2017

### Map Information:

This map represents the percentage of unduplicated clients with a primary diagnosis of opiate use disorder (OUD) served in each county during SFY 2017. The average rate of clients with a primary diagnosis of OUD across counties was 48.1%. The highest rates were found in Lawrence county (78.8%), Scioto county (78.4%), and Hardin county (70.2%). The lowest rates were found in Holmes county (17.5%), Paulding county (25.3%), and Geauga county (25.5%).

Counties that reported fewer than 25 clients are signified by gray, and no rate is given. Counties with 25-49 clients are signified by diagonal lines.

County borders are outlined in gray. ADAMHS Boards areas are outlined in black, and may overlap county borders.
