>>> FY 17 RFI: Evidence-Based Practices in Substance Use, Mental Health or Co-Occurring Disorders for Children, Adolescents and Young Adults in Ohio

OhioMHAS has issued a [Request for Information](#) to obtain information about evidence-based practices (EBPs) in use in Ohio for children, adolescents and/or youth and young adults in transition (ages 0-26) with substance use (SUD) and/or mental health (MH) disorders or co-occurring SUD and MH disorders. Information is sought for the purposes of determining current provider capacity and need for infrastructure support in the training and implementation of EBPs to the population of focus, and where indicated, to couple such programming with medication-assisted treatment. The Department also seeks to screen and expand integrated substance use and mental disorder treatment to effectively link and coordinate recovery services. **Responses are due by 2 p.m. on Dec. 9.** Questions regarding this process should be directed to BCYFgrants@oha.ohio.gov.
