The Ohio Youth-Led Prevention Network (OYLPN), with support from the Ohio Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services, is excited to announce a [new funding opportunity](#) to enhance the infrastructure of youth-led programming in Ohio. OYLPN seek grantees who are interested in deepening their knowledge of the theoretical basis of youth-led programming, preparing them to be leaders and resources in the field. Grantees will participate in a study group on prevention science, evidence-based strategies and youth empowerment. Grantees will be responsible for actively participating in each study group session and collectively developing resources to build the capacity of adult allies who facilitate youth-led programming.
