>>> FY2019 RFA SOR GPRA Training, Data Collection and Reporting (MHA-19-MEDDIR-SOR-GPRAReport-64)

As part of Ohio's State Opioid Response (SOR) project, OhioMHAS seeks to partner with a college or university to manage the required Government Performance and Results Act (GPRA) survey data collection and reporting for the Ohio SOR project. The selected applicant will provide training and support to the SOR providers collecting required Government Performance and Results Act (GPRA) data, monitor data collected for data integrity and regularly report to OhioMHAS relating to the data collection process. The GPRA requires data collection and reporting for all patients who receive SOR funded services. Ohio SOR participating providers are responsible for the GPRA data collection and submission of data to OhioMHAS. Selected applicant will facilitate and monitor this data collection and submission.
