>>> FY2019 RFP: OhioMHAS Quality Housing Criteria (MHA-19-TRS-SOR-HousingQuality-57)

The Ohio Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services (OhioMHAS) has established effectiveness and efficiency criteria which apply to any housing setting seeking levy, state (operating and capitol) or federal funds distributed by OhioMHAS or a local behavioral health authority. As part of Ohio's State Opiate Response (SOR) grant initiative, OhioMHAS is offering one statewide grant to a Housing Advocacy Organization to assist with administrative duties related to the Quality Housing Criteria. **An informational webinar has been planned for Jan. 16 from 1-2:30 p.m.** The conference call-in number is 614.230.0229 and then enter meeting ID: 68193.
