>>> FY19 RFA: State Opioid Response DEA DATA 2000 Waiver In-Person Trainings

As part of Ohio's State Opioid Response (SOR) initiative, the Ohio Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services (OhioMHAS) is seeking a vendor to provide 25 live trainings for physicians, certified nurse practitioners and/or physician assistants who are seeking to obtain a DEA DATA 2000 Waiver. The awardee will provide technical assistance and faculty for live courses which includes selection, training, facilitation, second-day waived physician presenter. General course management and oversight will also be provided by the awardee as well as CME tracking and provision and a registration website. The awardee will provide the training event planner with information on those attendees who qualify for a reimbursement as well as completed W-9s for those same individuals. Awardee will provide the required grant evaluation as required by OhioMHAS. All questions must be submitted to SORTreatment@mha.ohio.gov by 5:30 p.m. on March 15.
