>>> Upcoming Rule Changes to Affect Submission of PASRR Form (ODM 3622)

The Ohio Department of Medicaid (ODM) will be revising rules 5160-3-15, 5160-3-15.1 and 5160-3-15.2 of the Administrative Code pertaining to the Preadmission Screening and Resident Review (PASRR) process. Currently, submitters of the ODM 3622 can fill out a paper copy of the form and submit it to their regional PASSPORT Administrative Agency (PAA) for review. **Effective Dec. 30, 2019, the ODM 3622 must be submitted electronically through the [Healthcare Electronic Notification System \(HENS\)](#).** This change is necessary to improve efficiencies in the processing of the ODM 3622 screen forms by reducing paperwork and to enable accurate tracking of all ODM 3622 forms submitted.
