



Bucci Appointed Chief Executive Officer at Heartland Behavioral Healthcare

(COLUMBUS – November 26, 2019) The Ohio Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services today announced the appointment of Andrea M. Bucci as Chief Executive Officer of Heartland Behavioral Healthcare (HBH).

As CEO, Bucci will oversee approximately 250 employees and be responsible for the well-being, care and treatment of 132 patients at the Massillon psychiatric hospital. In addition to overseeing day-to-day hospital operations, Bucci will also manage relations with the Alcohol Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services (ADAMHS) Boards in the 11-county catchment area served by the hospital.

Bucci, who has worked at the hospital since 2006, was named acting CEO in March. She previously served as the hospital's Chief Operating Officer and as a Regional Environment of Care Director.

Bucci earned bachelor's degrees in Psychology and Criminal Justice Administration from Youngstown State University and is a second-year M.B.A. candidate at Columbia Southern University. She is a resident of North Jackson.

HBH is one of six Regional Psychiatric Hospitals maintained by OhioMHAS. The hospital serves residents from Ashland, Carroll, Columbiana, Holmes, Mahoning, Medina, Richland, Stark, Trumbull, Tuscarawas, and Wayne counties.
