We've read the Agreements and Assurances, but would still like to verify that funding through these projects might cover the following: Bus passes for use by clients for transport to appointments, Medications for medical conditions (exclusive of HIV medications or MAT). Also, would could funding be used to pay a one time security deposit to enable a client to secure housing, if employed?

The funding could cover bus passes and one time security deposits. It cannot be used on medications for medical conditions.

Number of individuals served
Number of staff trained
