VACCINATION UPDATE

NEW Vaccination Phases: Phase 1E, Phases 2C and 2D:
 Now eligible, Phase 1E ([graphic](#)) includes Ohioans with cancer, chronic kidney disease, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, heart disease, and obesity.
 Now eligible, Phase 2C ([graphic](#)) extends eligibility to Ohioans age 40 and up.
 Beginning on March 29, Phase 2D ([graphic](#)) will open the vaccine to **all** eligible Ohioans age 16 and up.
Note- individuals aged 16-17 will be eligible to receive the Pfizer vaccine, the only COVID-19 vaccine authorized for use for those under age 18.

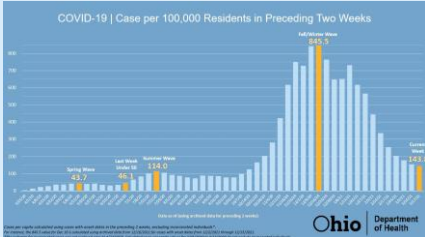
Vaccination Scheduling Tool: Ohio's centralized scheduling website will help Ohioans confirm they are eligible to be vaccinated, identify nearby providers, and schedule their vaccine appointments. Visit gettheshot.coronavirus.ohio.gov.

Mass Vaccination Sites: Ohio's mass vaccination clinic at Cleveland State University's Wolstein Center is now open. An additional 15 long-term mass vaccination clinics will open regionally across Ohio in the coming weeks. Visit coronavirus.ohio.gov for more information.

COVID-19 SAFETY UPDATE

Updated Health Orders: Ohio Department of Health has updated several health orders regarding [spring sports and extracurricular activities](#); [mass gatherings](#); [sports and entertainment](#); and [fair activities](#).

Indoor Air Quality Assistance Program: The program provides reimbursements to help cover the costs of inspections, assessments, maintenance, and improvements to indoor heating, ventilation, and air conditioning systems to control the spread of COVID-19.

The following facilities are eligible to apply: intermediate care facilities; hospices; senior centers; adult care facilities; waiver settings (group homes; and substance use treatment centers. Visit [BWC.ohio.gov](#) for more information.

Rapid testing: Ohio is making available at-home COVID-19 tests that can be self-administered outside a healthcare setting using telehealth services. Visit [coronavirus.ohio.gov](#) for more information.

TALKING POINTS FOR YOU

- The COVID-19 vaccines have been tested rigorously and are safe. The decision to receive a vaccine is a personal choice, but *[INSERT ORGANIZATION NAME]* hopes you choose to receive it when you are eligible.
